BIOGRAPHY

Christian Bogner, M.D is fighting to show the world the benefits of Medical Cannabis for the Autism Spectrum. He is a board-certified physician with clinical interests in nutritional research. Accomplishing a reestablishment of homeostasis for the body requires strategy, knowledge, spiritual research, inspired dedication, determination and proper detoxification. As a former Chief of Surgery, he has been trained to fix problems mechanically and understands the benefits of a healthy lifestyle to prevent unnecessary medical intervention. The panel consisted of medical doctors and they voted in favor. Numerous high profile Autism experts from Children's Hospital of Detroit as well as Henry Ford Hospital were testifying in support. It was the director of LARA Mike Zimmer who ultimately denied the vote of his own panel. Mr. Zimmer has no medical background. The petition was declined, but then used in numerous other states. Autism now is currently a qualifying condition for four states that regulate cannabis for medicinal purposes.
